MESSAGE FROM THE NEW INTERIM RABBI

Dear Shomrei Emunah Members:

I feel honored and privileged to write to you as the Interim Rabbi of Shomrei Emunah. I am grateful for the opportunity to continue the outstanding work of Rabbi Gottlieb, and look forward to a year of continued growth in the *Shul*. I hope to provide my personal support and assistance to each of you, as well as the leadership that the *Shul* requires.

As you may know I will be continuing in my capacity as the Director of the Jewish Learning Initiative at Johns Hopkins University, where I have served for two wonderful years. This role requires my presence on campus during the semester for *minyanim*, *shiurim*, study groups, meetings, and several *Shabbosos*. With the help of the search committee, the *Shul* board, and your input, I have invested much thought into designing a balance of my time and energies that will allow me to meet the needs of both communities.

I plan on being present at Shomrei Emunah for the overwhelming majority of *Shabbosos* during the calendar year. During the academic year [7 months], I will be at Johns Hopkins University for several *Shabbosos* each semester. The adult education committee and I will work together to make sure that proper coverage is arranged for those *Shabbosos*.

I expect to *daven* at the *Shul* throughout *Shabbos* and on Sunday mornings, and will regularly attend the 10:00 pm *Maariv minyan*. At times when Johns Hopkins University is closed I will be present for *Shacharis* during the week as well. I look forward to offering a variety of *Shiurim* and classes throughout the year.

I will be available for lifecycle events, *Halachik sh'elos* (questions) and personal appointments. You may contact me at any time via e-mail (rabbimarwick@shomreiemunah.org) or by phone. If I do not answer the phone, please leave me a message including the purpose of the call and specific times I can reach you, and I will be sure to respond. For emergencies please call the *Shul* office or *Shul* President and they will get in touch with me immediately.

I am excited to serve in this capacity and look forward to meeting each and every one of you over the coming weeks.
