President's Message

Building Update

As is apparent to all, the construction project is moving along at a very swift pace. The exterior is now 100% complete and the front steps of the social hall may in fact be done by the time you are reading this. The Jerusalem stone installation has begun in the gallery and most of the infrastructure work in the Main Sanctuary is complete. In the next few weeks, the ceiling and lighting for will be installed which means that finishes such as wallpaper, wood and carpeting are not far behind!

The Executive Board and Building committee have met extensively to try and create a seating plan for the shul that will be pleasing to as many of our members as possible. To that end, we have weighed the vote (which had the largest number of votes cast for Tables & Chairs), together with the concerns expressed by those opposed to the idea. We added in cost factors, flexibility and aesthetics, and arrived at a design which we believe will be beautiful. The Main Sanctuary will have four columns in the Men's section (not that different from what we have now). The center sections will be chairs only with arms. The sections along the walls will have Tables & Chairs. These chairs will not have arms. The Women's section will have arm chairs throughout.

I would like to thank you all for expressing your feelings about the seating arrangement. It is our collective hope that the new shul will be a place where we are all comfortable and able to come together with Achdus in service to Hashem.

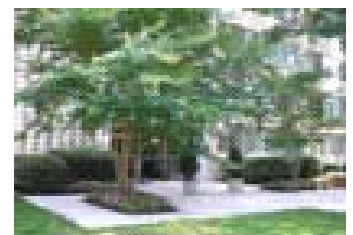
