

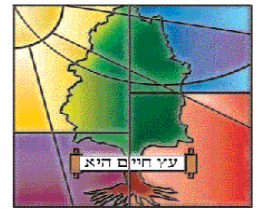

FROM THE TZEDAKAH COMMITTEE...

As you may have noticed, there have been four bowls on each of the *Bimahs* since *Rosh Chodesh Ellul*. Here is more information about what the money is used for:

Bernard Yaffe Tzedakah Fund: Money from this bowl (and the *Pushkas* labeled "Tzedakah") is distributed to local people in need, local institutions that provide help to those in need (e.g., *Ahavas Yisroel*, *Gevuras Yarden/JCN*, *Bikkur Cholim*, etc.), local educational institutions, our shul, and people in need and charitable institutions in Israel. Checks should be made out to **Shomrei Emunah, BYTF**.

Bedek HaBayis: Money from this bowl (and the *Pushkas* labeled "Bedek HaBayis") is used for day-to-day upkeep, operations and expenses of the *shul*. Checks can be made out to **Congregation Shomrei Emunah**.

Shomrei Emunah Israel Fund: As announced by Rabbi Marwick, money from this bowl will be earmarked for the Big Brother program to support the children of Roi Klein, A"H, a Major in the Golani Brigade of the Israeli Defense Forces who gave his life to save his fellow soldiers. Checks can be made out to **Shomrei Emunah Israel Fund** with **Big Brother** on the memo line.

Old City Anniyim Matching Fund: Also as announced, money from this bowl will be distributed directly to people in need in the Old City of Jerusalem (with no overhead) by a dedicated individual known to Rabbi Marwick and members of our shul. Funds collected during this time are being matched locally and then by an out-of-town benefactor for a total of two dollars for every one dollar given. **(This means that if you put in a check for \$18.00, the Old City's poor will receive \$54.00!).** Checks can be made out to **Shomrei Emunah BYTF** with **Matching Fund** on the memo line.
